The RJMEC meeting considered the following agenda:

- a) Review and adoption of RJMEC Rules of Procedure and Resolution Template;
- b) Briefings from the UNMISS on the humanitarian situation in South Sudan;
- c) Briefing from Chairpersons of NCAC and CTSAMVM on the situation in South Sudan; and
- d) Date of the next RJMEC meeting.

Following an opening statement by the IGAD Special Envoy for South Sudan H.E Dr. Ismail Wais, statement by the Interim Chairperson of RJMEC H.E Lt. General (Rtd) Augustino S.k Njoroge, and reports from the UNMISS Special Representative of the

Secretary General (SRSG), Chairpersons of NPTC, CTSAMVM and NCACA and deliberations by members, the RJMEC Council resolved as follows:

1. Welcomed the reconstitution of the RJMEC by IGAD and expressed deep appreciation to H.E Dr. Ismail Wais, the IGAD Special Envoy for South Sudan for his personal contribution that led to the success of the revitalisation process;
2. Congratulated the interim Chairperson Ambassador Augustino S.K Njoroge and all the representatives nominated to the RJMEC Council;
3. Endorsed the statement of the RJMEC interim Chairperson on the status of implementation of the RARCSS;
4. Commended the Parties for the positive steps in the implementation of the R-ARCSS in particular nominations of representatives to the various institutions and mechanisms of the agreement and for the ongoing confidence building and encouraged further progress;
5. Endorsed the RJMEC Rules of Procedure 2018;
6. Took note of the reports of the UNMISS, NCAC and CTSAMVM and urged immediate implementation of their recommendations;
7. Called upon all parties and stakeholders to observe the permanent ceasefire in all parts of the country without exception and to guarantee unimpeded humanitarian access;
8. Appealed to the international partners and friends of South Sudan to support implementation of the Pre-Transitional activities of the R-ARCSS;
9. Called upon the IGAD Office of the Special Envoy to ensure the immediate formation of the JDB, IBC and TBC;
10. That next RJMEC meeting should be convened on 12th December 2018 in Juba;
11. Decides to remain seized of this matter.
